4 Read the nutritional facts & ingredients on some foods you eat. Discuss the nutritional value of the food.	5 Listen! It's the #1 thing a parent can do to support their child. Ask them to share what they learned today.	6 <u>ELECTION DAY</u> Talk about civics. 18 Talk to your child about his/her favorite subject in school.
